**WHEREAS**, there are more than 1,000 apprenticeable occupations available, designed to meet the needs of many high-growth, high-demand industries in the new Nevada; and

**WHEREAS**, Registered Apprenticeship provides a pathway to economic advancement, post-secondary education and a meaningful career; and

**WHEREAS**, high-quality Registered Apprenticeship programs have provided opportunities and jobs to Nevadans for decades; and

**WHEREAS**, Registered Apprenticeship provides employers and industries customized training to develop their own skilled workforce; and

**WHEREAS**, during the 2017 Legislative Session work was done to coordinate and align workforce systems, expand existing programs and populations, and diversify to new and innovative areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Nevada recognizes Registered Apprenticeships and the partners who provide these opportunities to citizens of the Silver State;
