

LABORERS

As a Construction Craft Laborer (CCL), your work can include construction, remodeling, and demolition of buildings, dams, bridges, airports, streets, sewers, tunnels, etc. CCLs may do soil compaction, pavement breaking, pipelaying, placement and finishing of concrete, landscaping, perform environmental remediation (including asbestos, hazardous waste, lead and radiation abatement), cutting and burning, rigging and signaling, sandblasting, concrete cutting, traffic control, tending to other trades, and other work coming under the Laborers' Jurisdiction. CCLs work in all kinds of weather and must be prepared and dress accordingly. CCLs may work at heights, in deep trenches, underground and in confined spaces. The work of a Laborer is physically demanding!



Minimum Requirements to Apply:

18 +

Physically able to perform the work of the trade with or without reasonable accommodation

Legally residing in the United States

Application Process

- Complete application
- Attend 1 hour orientation
- Take written aptitude test: construction, hand and power tools, machinery, safety and math
- Participate in an interview
- Selected candidates will be invited to attend a two-day physical assessment
