4. **Approval of January 21, 2026, meeting minutes** – (For possible action)

Chair Soderberg called for a motion to approve the meeting minutes. It was moved by **Tony Machabee** and seconded by **Councilman Scott Black**. The motion carried.

5. **State Compliance Policy (SCP) Revisions** - (For possible action)

- **1.0 Membership of Local Workforce Development Boards**
- **2.3 Youth Standing Committee**

Chair Soderberg acknowledged Kara Abe to present two non-substantiative state compliance policies that have been revised to be presented to the committee for approval.

Kara Abe, ESD Program Chief, WISS, stated that the non-substantive changes presented bring the WIOA state compliance policies up to date.

SCP 1.0 – Membership of Local Workforce Development Boards

This policy outlines how local workforce boards are established and governed under WIOA. It clarifies that the governor sets statewide membership criteria that the chief elected officials appointed members through an established nomination process. The policy highlights the requirements that business representatives must have significant hiring or decision-making authority and that each board must be chaired by a business representative to ensure strong private sector leadership. Current revisions focus on compliance updates, refreshed federal references and formatting improvements.

SCP 2.3 – Youth Standing Committee

This policy explains that while WIOA does not require a youth council, local workforce development boards may establish a standing youth committee to support youth program planning, oversight and service delivery. Federal guidance encourages boards and chief elected officials to use a standing youth committee for this purpose, and existing youth councils may serve in this role if they meet the criteria. Revisions to this policy update the terminology to align with the code of federal regulations

Chair Soderberg called for a motion to approve the SCPs. It was moved by **Councilman Scott Black** and seconded by **Tony Machabee**. The motion carried.

6. **New Business from Executive Committee Members and Next Steps** -

Tony Machabee inquired about the next steps to set up a tour of the Truckee Meadows Community College (TMCC) campus to discuss their workforce development initiatives for the June 18th meeting.
